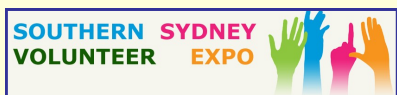

Community Information Desk

This 'desk' is situated at Westfield Hurstville Shopping Centre and stocks a wealth of literature on a variety of subjects. It is staffed by volunteers from 10am to 3pm Monday to Fridays. A JP service is also provided on several days of the week.

Carss Park Community Centre

Opened in January 2009, the centre provides a wide range of activities for the local community:

- A Broadband for Seniors computer kiosk operates Monday-Friday. Volunteer tutors help seniors learn basic computer skills. Bookings essential.
- Parenting courses: Positive parenting seminars and courses are offered throughout the year. Call us for dates.
- Strengthening for over 60s, a gentle exercise program designed and run by St George Hospital staff on Friday mornings.
